MUSIC TECH

Marking Period Assessment Cartoon Animation Score

Objective: Students will create a Music Score using loops and an mp3 plus at least two live performances based on a given public domain cartoon video. Students will utilize a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 15 different tracks to create dialog, music background, sound effects, etc. for the cartoon. Students will apply their loop browsing skills, software instrument skills, song importing and song editing knowledge to compose their song.

Procedure: Open GarageBand and create a new song. Label it MPA Cartoon + your last name and save it to your folder on the desktop. You must use pre-recorded loops to create your song plus an mp3 in conjunction with the loops. You MUST include at least two live tracks into your composition. Click and drag the movie "Krazy Kat" to the Timeline. Then delete the Movie Sound Track (NOT the Movie Track). Now you can begin to compose the score to the cartoon. Please keep in mind that you should fade out the music at the end and use good editing techniques. Remember that you must use at least 6 and no more than 15 tracks. The movie track does not count as one of your 6 to 15 tracks. When you are happy with your results, save your project. You will present your project to the class on January 27th - 30th.

Timeline: You will have 6 class periods to complete the entire project.

Grade: This is the culmination of everything you have learned in class. Your grade will be based upon creativity, the appropriateness of the music you have chosen/composed for the movie, and how well you edited (volume, fades, etc.) the project. Remember that you must have a musical soundtrack, dialog, sound effects and an mp3 (imported song).
